PURPOSE

The material listed on the attached Bid Form has been declared surplus by the County of Imperial Board of Supervisors. The County of Imperial (also referred to as the "County") is requesting bids for the purchase of this equipment on a price for the lot basis. There is no minimum bid.

I. PAYMENT AND PASSAGE OF TITLE

Purchaser must make payment by certified check or cashier's check to the County upon receipt of notification of acceptance of bid, and before removing any of the items from the premises. Title shall pass upon payment in full. All sales are subject to sales tax unless payment for material being bought for resale is accompanied by a valid resale tax exemption certificate. Should County not receive payment within ten (10) working days, County shall have the right to withdraw its offer for sale and to offer the merchandise for sale to other prospective Purchasers.

II. DELIVERY AND REMOVAL OF PROPERTY

Purchaser shall remove the property at its expense within seven (7) calendar days after passage of title. Purchaser shall be liable for any damage to property caused by removal operation.

If for any reason the Purchaser fails to remove any property within fourteen (14) calendar days after passage of title, the property will be deemed abandoned, and the County at its sole discretion may store or resell the property at the Purchaser's sole risk and expense. In addition, Purchaser shall be liable for any rent or damage suffered by the County because of Purchaser's failure to remove any property. Payment made to the County by the Purchaser who abandoned the property **shall not be refunded.**

RISK OF LOSS

After passage of title to the Purchaser, and prior to removal, all risk of loss, damage or destruction from any cause whatsoever shall be borne by the Purchaser, except for willful damage or destruction by the County, in which event the only liability of the County shall be to refund the portion of the purchase price applicable to the destroyed goods. After award and prior to passage of title, the County shall be responsible only for the exercise of reasonable care for protection of the property for fourteen (14) calendar days and in event of damage to all or any part thereof the County's only liability shall be to reduce the sale price applicable to the damaged goods.

III. VARIATION IN QUANTITY OR WEIGHT

No adjustment for variation will be made when property is sold on a "price for the lot" basis.

IV. WARRANTIES

All surplus items are sold on "AS IS/WHERE IS" basis.

Notwithstanding any other provision herein, in any case where Purchaser or prospective Purchaser claims and proves County liable for breach or other civil wrong arising hereunder, the sole and only remedy for such breach or other civil wrong shall be and is limited to the value paid or offered to be paid, and all other remedies (including compensatory damages, economic loss or other resulting loss) are hereby disclaimed.

VI. REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION
